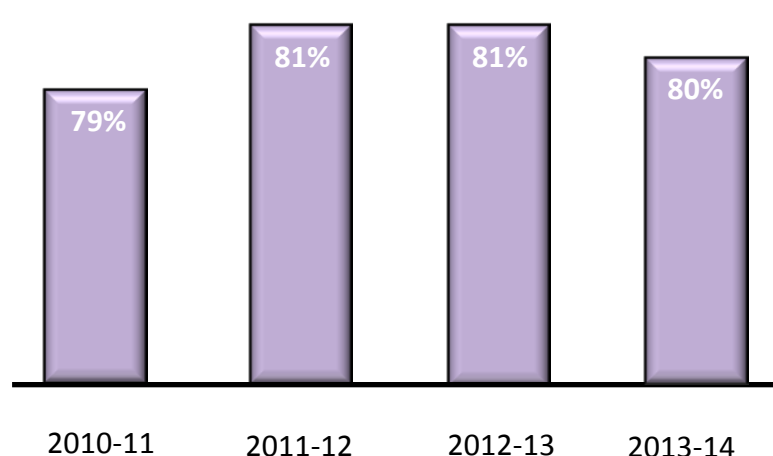
Why measure?
